

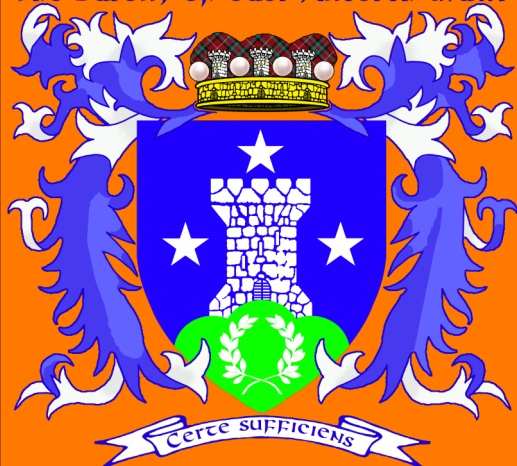

Stay safe, wash your hands, wear masks when they are appropriate, and we look forward to seeing you soon.

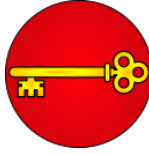

Greetings! There have been several events and awards for our barony members!

Poorman's Pennsic had a court on August 27th and the following stuff happened while TRM were present:

Sofonisba Vespasiana Gabrielli was put on Vigil and then elevated to a Pelican! In the Order of the Pelican, members may choose to swear fealty, but are not required to do so. The candidate must have attained the standard of service to the Society or any of its branches equal to that of his or her prospective peers, which is above and beyond that normally expected of members of the Society. Blazon: (Tinctureless) A pelican vulning itself. (Tinctureless) A pelican in its piety. (Fieldless) A chapeau gules trimmed ermine. VIVAT Sofonisba! Thank you for all your service to our barony and to NORTHSHIELD!!!

THL Magnus Vargrson was awarded the Order of the Hand of Tyr. This (grant level) award is given to those who have distinguished themselves over time by performing, with all due courtesy, outstanding service on behalf of the kingdom. Members are expected to continue conspicuous service and to help others find their own opportunities for service. [formerly known as the Order of Tyr] Blazon: (Fieldless) On a hand fesswise sable a Týr rune argent. Vivat Magnus!

Thora Heri was added into the Order of the Black Griffin. This order includes those who have, over time, demonstrated great prowess, chivalry, and leadership in Armored Combat. Members will be responsible for continued, conspicuous activity in Armored Combat and for helping others become involved and proficient. [formerly known as Iron Griffin Legion] Blazon: (Fieldless) A griffin sustaining a sword sable. Vivat Thora!

At Crown/Coronation event on September 10th the following members received an Augmentation of Arms. An Augmentation of Arms may be awarded by the Crown to specially honor a person for service to the Kingdom above and beyond the call of duty. Each augmentation is a specific charge at the Crown's discretion, to be added to the individual's heraldic arms. Vivat to Sofonisba Vespasiana Gabrielli, Armond le Charpentier, Deonysia of Rye, Kale Phokaina Kourkouaina, Margaret Malise de Kyrkyntolaghe, Merouda Pendray, Rosamund of Newenham, Tatiana Marana Melville, and Thora Heri. Vivant!!!

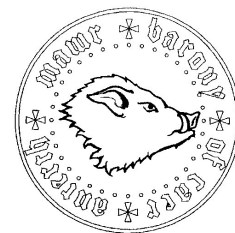
From the Autocrats of Boars Head:

A Riddle from Mistress Drisilka the Sensible

What city in medieval Italy has "a saint without a name, a cafe without walls, and a meadow without grass"?

Answer: Padua.

The basilica honoring St. Anthony and has his tomb is simply called "Basilica del Santo". The cafe without doors is Pedrocchi's (because it remained permanently open from 1831-1916). The meadow without grass is the Prato della Valle in the south of the city. The vast oval space was once the site of a Roman amphitheatre, later a swamp, and later a place where "Battles of Love" were held, which were highly stylized festivals with decorated floats and elaborate costumes. Today it is an elegant address with huge balconied apartments overlooking the Prato--with statues, fountains, and walkways, but no grass.
