From the Minister of Arts & Sciences

Greetings unto the Populace of Caer Anterth Mawr,

Gardening, camping, and for those with outdoor shops blacksmithing and woodworking season is finally here! Do you have a challenge with in-ground gardening? Medieval raised bed gardens were often made with a wattle design – vertical hardwood stakes driven in the ground, with horizontal slats, and of course the assembly filled with dirt. Traditionally the slats were of willow, but buckthorn, or other hardwood or softwood stripped of bark will work. If the stakes are greenwood, those definitely need to be stripped of bark to prevent re-rooting. This method is also good for decorative fencing around an in-ground garden. There are a number of good YouTube videos for both raised beds and fences.

Are you getting started with camping? Depending on your camping style and goals you may wish to acquire or build a medieval table. There have been a couple of table-making classes in the past in the Barony, the first of which was taught by Duke Corin. This table featured a hinged 2 foot X 4 foot top, X-frame legs, and a stretcher, with tusk and tenon to hold the stretcher in place. The legs and stretcher could be stored inside the tabletop for transportation and storage; this is a very useful and practical design. Another good camping table is a simple plank top with knock-down medieval "sawhorse" legs. Several years ago quite a few of these were made for the feast at the Green Knight event.

There are a number of skilled woodworkers in the Barony who can advise or help with construction of either of these types of tables.

If A&S activities are of interest to you as something to learn, or if you have knowledge and skill, and a willingness to teach, please let me know. Looking forward to facilitating more opportunities for learning A&S this summer.


