From the Archery Captain & Thrown Weapons Marshal

Archers and throwers to the Line! Per Society and Kingdom guidelines, participants who are not fully vaccinated must wear masks or face covering, and to maintain social distancing on the range. Those who are fully vaccinated, as defined by the CDC, do not need to wear a mask outdoors.

Caer Anterth Mawr's archers and throwers did the barony proud in the recent Wishing & Waiting (WW) tournaments. For the Ring of Pearls archery challenge, I tied for first place with a score of 13, Rhys and Tanja were in 4th place with scores of 10. Karl finished in 5th place with a score of 9. I came in third place, on axes, in the Barons' Thrown Weapons challenge. Vivant to everyone who participated!

The days are starting to grow noticeably We have about 6-7 more Thursday night practices left. So, let us make the most of them.

Archery Practices will continue to be held twice a week. Thursdays will be at 6:30 pm at Kinnickinnic River Parkway (2050 W Kinnickinnic River Pkwy, Milwaukee, WI 53215). Sunday archery practices will be scheduled for 10 am at Menomonee Park (W220 N7884 Town Line Rd, Menomonee Falls-\$5/car entrance fee).

The Sunday August 1st practice will be a very special one. We will hold joint archery practice with our neighbors from the Barony of Jararvellir at Rock River Park, in Fort Atkinson, on the range that we have held our baronial championships on in the not distant past.

Thrown weapons practice will be on Thursday, August 12th and 26th, at 6:30 pm at Kinnickinnic River Parkway (2050 W Kinnickinnic River Pkwy, Milwaukee, WI 53215). Loaner weapons are available. **Throwers must wear close toed shoes!**

Our neighbors in the Barony of Windhaven are holding Missile Mayhem II on September 25, 2021. This will be an event for archery, thrown weapons, siege engines, and other fun. Caer Anterth Mawr's baronial archery and thrown weapons championships will be held the next day, on September 26th, at the Delafield American Legion.

Sofonisba and Armond would like to step down as autocrats for Border Skirmish. We also need a site. Will advertise in the Tower to that effect.






For the Midsummer Baronial Court, the scribes of Caer Anterth Mawr created beautiful works of art for the recipients of the baronial honors.






